ACCEPTANCE

In consideration of the above Assignment and terms and conditions stated on this contract, we hereby assume and agree to make all payments and abide by all the conditions stated, including all responsibilities in arranging for said breeding service with stallion owner.

1. That the breeding season in force for this contract begins February 1, and closes June 30, and mare owner shall be entitled to one return privilege in the following year for the same mare, or in the event of the death of said mare (or vet-certified breeding unsoundness) substitute, mare.

2. That should the above named stallion die or become unfit for breeding purposes, or is sold and said mare has not been serviced by said stallion, upon proper verification of the above from the stallion owner, then any monies paid by mare owner to the NWMSOF shall be:

a. refunded as FULL credit applied to another available stallion during the CURRENT year ONLY (no cash refund)

b. refunded as FULL credit in the following year auction ONLY (no cash refund)

c. ONE-HALF of purchase fee will be refunded in cash NWMSOF must be notified in writing by June 1 of said year, or all becomes Null & Void.

3. Stallion owner is not responsible for any disease, accident, sickness, and/or death of mare or foal.

4. Mare must be halter broken and in sound breeding condition. Health papers and/or Coggins will be at the stallion owners request. Mare owner may be asked to sign contract produced by stallion owner.

5. Mare owner will be responsible for all mare care and expenses including any veterinary expenses.

6. Breeders Certificate will be furnished when foal is on the ground and upon payment in full service fee and mare care expenses.
